13-1510. REQUIREMENTS; PENALTY.

(A) UNLICENSED OPERATION.

AN ORGANIZATION MAY NOT CONDUCT A GAMING EVENT UNLESS THE ORGANIZATION HAS ACQUIRED THE APPROPRIATE LICENSE.

(B) OBEYING LICENSE — ORGANIZATION.

AN ORGANIZATION SHALL OBEY THE TERMS OF A LICENSE.

(C) SAME — PERSON SIGNING APPLICATION.

EACH PERSON WHO SIGNED AN APPLICATION FOR A LICENSE SHALL OBEY THE TERMS OF THE LICENSE.

(D) FILING REPORT.

A PERSON SHALL FILE THE REPORT REQUIRED UNDER § 13-1509 OF THIS SUBTITLE.

(E) PENALTY.

A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 30 DAYS OR A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$1,000 OR BOTH.

(F) SEPARATE VIOLATION.

EACH DAY THAT A GAMING EVENT IS OPERATED WITHOUT A LICENSE OR IN VIOLATION OF ANY OF THE TERMS OF THE LICENSE IS A SEPARATE VIOLATION.

AN ORGANIZATION THAT FAILS TO FILE A REPORT REQUIRED BY § 13-1509 OF THIS SUBTITLE IS NOT ENTITLED TO A LICENSE UNDER THIS SUBTITLE UNTIL THE LATER OF:
