13-1706. PENALTIES.

(A) IN GENERAL.

A PERSON WHO VIOLATES A PROVISION OF §§ 13–1702 THROUGH 13–1704 OF THIS SUBTITLE IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 1 YEAR OR A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$1,000 OR BOTH.

(B) SEPARATE VIOLATION.

EACH DAY THAT A PERSON IS IN VIOLATION UNDER THIS SECTION IS A SEPARATE VIOLATION.
