

13-2428. SAME — APPLICATION.

(A) IN GENERAL.

(1) AN APPLICANT FOR A WHOLESALER'S LICENSE SHALL:

(I) SUBMIT TO THE AGENCY AN APPLICATION ON THE FORM THAT THE AGENCY PROVIDES; AND

(II) SUBJECT TO PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, PAY TO THE AGENCY AN ANNUAL FEE OF \$500.

(2) THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS SHALL WAIVE THE ANNUAL FEE FOR A VOLUNTEER FIRE COMPANY OR A VOLUNTEER RESCUE COMPANY.

(B) DISPOSITION OF LICENSE FEES.

THE AGENCY SHALL CREDIT LICENSE FEES COLLECTED UNDER SUBSECTION (A)(1)(II) OF THIS SECTION TO THE GENERAL FUND OF THE COUNTY.

REVISOR'S NOTE: Subsection (a)(1)(i) of this section is standard language added to state expressly that which was only implied in the former law — i.e., applications must be made on the form the agency requires.

Subsections (a)(1)(ii) and (2) and (c) of this section are new language derived without substantive change from former Art. 27, § 255C(m)(2) and (3) and, as it related to the application and fee for a wholesaler's license, (1).

In subsection (a)(1)(ii) of this section, the reference to an "annual" fee is added for clarity. This addition is supported by the reference to an annual fee in former Art. 27, § 255C(m)(2) — now subsection (a)(2) of this section.

Subsection (b) of this section is revised to clarify that the agency is responsible for crediting license fees it collects to the county general fund.

Criminal history records checks of applicants are obtained in accordance with § 13-2419(d) of this subtitle.
