13-2438. CRIMINAL PENALTIES.

(A) IN GENERAL.

(1) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES § 13-2436 OF THIS SUBTITLE IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING:

(I) FOR A FIRST VIOLATION, \$5,000; OR

(II) FOR EACH SUBSEQUENT VIOLATION, \$10,000.

(2) EACH SALE OR OFFER OF A CHANCE FROM A TIP JAR IS A SEPARATE VIOLATION.

(B) ACTION AGAINST LIQUOR LICENSE.

IF A PERSON CONVICTED UNDER THIS SECTION HAS A LIQUOR LICENSE, THE AGENCY SHALL RECOMMEND TO THE BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS FOR WASHINGTON COUNTY THAT THE BOARD SUSPEND THE PERSON'S LIQUOR LICENSE FOR NOT LESS THAN 15 DAYS.
