# **Article - Business Regulation**

#### 4-407.

(a) Except as provided in § 10–226 of the State Government Article, before the Secretary takes any final action under § 4–405(b), § 4–406, OR § 4–416 of this subtitle, the Secretary shall give the person against whom the action is contemplated an opportunity for a hearing before the Secretary.

- (b) [(1)] To determine the amount of the penalty, the Secretary shall consider:
  - [(i)] (1) the seriousness of the violation:
  - [(ii)](2) the harm caused by the violation;
  - [(iii)](3) the good faith of the violator;
  - [(iv)] (4) any history of previous violations by the violator; and
  - [(v)](5) any other relevant factors.
