## Assisted Living Programs - Assisted Living Managers - Training Requirements

FOR the purpose of requiring certain individuals employed by certain assisted living programs, by a certain date, to complete a manager training course and certain continuing education that meets certain requirements; subjecting an assisted living program to a certain civil money penalty under certain circumstances; exempting certain individuals from certain training requirements; authorizing the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene to require certain individuals to take a certain training course under certain circumstances; authorizing an assisted living program to request an extension of a certain time period for complying with certain requirements; requiring the Department to ensure that certain programs are affordable and accessible; requiring the Department, in consultation with certain organizations, to develop certain guidelines; requiring the Department, in consultation with certain consumers and providers, to conduct a certain evaluation; requiring the Department to submit a certain report to certain committees of the General Assembly on or before a certain date; and generally relating to training requirements for assisted living managers.
