

(B) THE REPORT SHALL INCLUDE THE PROJECTS AND SERVICES DEVELOPED AND FUNDED BY THE OFFICE AND THE HEALTH CARE PROBLEMS THAT THE GRANT FUNDS ARE INTENDED TO AMELIORATE.

(C) THE REPORT MAY INCLUDE ANY RECOMMENDATIONS FOR ADMINISTRATIVE OR LEGISLATIVE ACTION THAT IT DEEMS APPROPRIATE.

CHAPTER 320

(House Bill 92)

AN ACT concerning

Vehicle Laws - Clarification of Rights for Wheelchair Use

FOR the purpose of clarifying that a person using a wheelchair at an intersection is subject to all traffic control signals, and at other locations, has the same rights and is subject to the restrictions applicable to pedestrians under certain provisions of law; providing an exception for wheelchair use to a prohibition against driving a vehicle on a sidewalk or sidewalk area; eliminating a certain restriction relating to the times within which a person with a disability may use a ~~wheelchair~~ special vehicle on sidewalks or sidewalk areas; altering an exception to the prohibition against driving a vehicle on a sidewalk or a sidewalk area; defining a certain term; and generally relating to persons using wheelchairs.
