SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages

4–201.

(a) A Class A light wine license may be issued only in:

- (1) Baltimore County;
- ~~(2)~~ (2) *CALVERT COUNTY*;
- ~~(3)~~ (3) Carroll County;
- ~~(4)~~ (4) Dorchester County;
- ~~(5)~~ (5) Frederick County;
- ~~(6)~~ (6) Garrett County;

- ~~(9)~~ (9) QUEEN ANNE'S COUNTY;
- (10) *ST. MARY'S COUNTY*;
- ~~[(8)]~~ ~~(9)~~ (11) Somerset County;
- ~~[(9)]~~ ~~(10)~~ (12) Talbot County; and
- ~~[(10)]~~ ~~(11)~~ (13) Washington County.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 2004.
