- (A) IN THIS SECTION, "FAMILY COUNCIL" MEANS A GROUP OF INDIVIDUALS WHO WORK TOGETHER TO PROTECT THE RIGHTS OF AND IMPROVE THE QUALITY OF LIFE OF RESIDENTS OF A NURSING HOME.
- (B) (1) A FAMILY COUNCIL FOR A NURSING HOME MAY CONSIST OF THE FOLLOWING MEMBERS:
 - (I) RESIDENTS OF A NURSING HOME:
 - (II) MEMBERS OF A RESIDENT'S FAMILY, OR
- (II) AN INDIVIDUAL APPOINTED BY THE RESIDENT, OR IF THE RESIDENT IS INCAPABLE OF APPOINTING AN INDIVIDUAL, AN INDIVIDUAL APPOINTED BY THE RESIDENT'S FAMILY.
 - (III) FRIENDS OF A RESIDENT; OR
 - (IV) REPRESENTATIVES OF TWO OR MORE RESIDENTS.
- (2) (I) SUBJECT TO SUBPARAGRAPH (II) OF THIS PARAGRAPH, A FAMILY COUNCIL MAY NOT BE CREATED OR LED BY THE OWNER, OPERATOR, OR STAFF OF A NURSING HOME.
- (II) IN ORDER TO FACILITATE THE DEVELOPMENT OF A FAMILY COUNCIL, THE OWNER, OPERATOR, OR STAFF OF A NURSING HOME MAY LEAD THE
