SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Public Safety

12 - 901.

- (a) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.
- (I) "MODEL STEAM BOILER" MEANS A BOILER THAT IS:
 - (1) INDIVIDUALLY FABRICATED FOR NONCOMMERCIAL USE:
- (2) USED PRIMARILY FOR DEMONSTRATION, EXHIBITION, OR EDUCATIONAL PURPOSES; AND
 - (3) NOT FOR PROFIT.
- [(i)] (J) "Power boiler" means a boiler in which steam or other vapor is generated at a pressure of more than 15 psig.
- [(j)] (K) (1) "Pressure vessel" means a vessel in which the pressure is obtained:
 - (i) from an external source; or
 - (ii) by the application of heat from:
 - an indirect source; or
 - a direct source other than a boiler.
- (2) "Pressure vessel" does not include a pipe, piping component, or structure whose primary function is to transport fluids.
 - [(k)] (L) "Secretary" means the Secretary of Labor, Licensing, and Regulation.
