- (II) MAY BE USED ONLY FOR THE EMPLOYMENT PURPOSE AUTHORIZED BY THIS SECTION.
- (4) THE SUBJECT OF A CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORDS CHECK UNDER THIS SECTION MAY CONTEST THE CONTENTS OF THE PRINTED STATEMENT ISSUED BY THE CENTRAL REPOSITORY AS PROVIDED IN § 10–223 OF THE CRIMINAL PROCEDURE ARTICLE.
- (C) (D) THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE OF PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY SHALL PROPOSE AND THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY SHALL ADOPT GUIDELINES TO CARRY OUT THIS SECTION.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2004.

CHAPTER 365

(House Bill 688)

AN ACT concerning

State Treasury - Unpresented Checks Fund

FOR the purpose of altering the procedures the Treasurer must follow in asking the Comptroller to credit the amount of certain unpresented checks to the Unpresented Checks Fund; altering the procedures for transferring a certain portion of the balance of the Fund to the General Fund; removing a prohibition on reissuing checks after a certain period; specifying the procedures to be followed in voiding an unpresented check; exempting unpresented checks credited to the Fund from certain statutory provisions; and generally relating to the Unpresented Checks Fund.
