- (2) A COURT MAY ORDER AN INDIVIDUAL TO PARTICIPATE IN THE PRETRIAL RELEASE PROGRAM IF THE INDIVIDUAL:
- $\hspace{1cm}$ (I) $\hspace{1cm}$ APPEARS BEFORE THE COURT AFTER BEING CHARGED AND DETAINED ON BOND; AND
- (II) MEETS THE ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS OF PARAGRAPH (4) OF THIS SUBSECTION.
- (3) THE COURT MAY MAKE THE ORDER AT THE IMPOSITION OF BOND, ON REVIEW OF BOND, OR ANY OTHER TIME DURING THE INDIVIDUAL'S PRETRIAL DETENTION.
- (4) AN INDIVIDUAL IS ELIGIBLE FOR THE PRETRIAL RELEASE PROGRAM IF THE INDIVIDUAL:
- (I) IS RECOMMENDED TO THE COURT FOR PLACEMENT IN THE PROGRAM BY THE PROGRAM STAFF; $\frac{AND}{A}$
- (II) HAS NO OTHER CHARGES FOR A FELONY OR A VIOLATION OF A CRIME OF VIOLENCE AS DEFINED IN § 14–101 OF THE CRIMINAL LAW ARTICLE PENDING IN ANY JURSIDICTION; AND
 - (II) HAS NO OTHER CHARGES PENDING IN ANY JURISDICTION; AND
- $\frac{\langle HH \rangle}{\langle III \rangle}$ IS NOT IN DETENTION FOR OR BEEN PREVIOUSLY CONVICTED OF:
- 1. A CRIME OF VIOLENCE LISTED IN § 14–101 OF THE CRIMINAL LAW ARTICLE; $\underline{\Theta R}$
 - 2. A FELONY; OR
 - 2. A FELONY; OR
