

(2) (II) REQUIRING THE TAX BE PAID TO THE COUNTY IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE TERMS OF THE COUNTY ORDINANCE.

(2) A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION THAT COLLECTS THE TAX AND REMITS THE TAX TO THE COUNTY MAY DEDUCT FROM THE REVENUES COLLECTED A FEE, NOT TO EXCEED 2% OF THE REVENUES COLLECTED, FOR ADMINISTRATIVE COSTS.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2004.

CHAPTER 402

(House Bill 1167)

AN ACT concerning

Higher Education - Maryland Digital Library - Established

FOR the purpose of establishing the Maryland Digital Library in the Maryland Higher Education Commission; providing for the purpose of the Maryland Digital Library; establishing the composition of the Maryland Digital Library; authorizing the Maryland Higher Education Commission to encourage certain institutions to meet certain goals; authorizing the Maryland Digital Library, in collaboration with certain ~~libraries~~ entities, to develop certain programs; establishing a Maryland Digital Library Advisory Council; requiring the Maryland Digital Library Advisory Council to submit a certain report to the Commission on or before a certain date each year; and generally relating to the establishment of the Maryland Digital Library.
