

(4) [Deputies] DEPUTY SHERIFFS are not entitled to any additional compensation for rendering services incident to their office. The County Council shall levy and collect annual taxes on the assessable property in the county in an amount sufficient to pay the salaries and allowances of the Sheriff and [his] THE SHERIFF'S deputies.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2004.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

(a) Before an organization may conduct a gaming event, the organization shall obtain a permit from the county commissioners.
