(ii) 5 days after the Commissioner refuses to renew the [certificate of qualification] LICENSE and gives notice of the refusal to the holder.

- (a) On or before September 30 of the renewal year, a person whose insurance adviser's [certificate of qualification] LICENSE has expired may reinstate the expired [certificate of qualification] LICENSE by:
- (1) filing with the Commissioner the appropriate reinstatement application;
- (2) paying to the Commissioner the applicable reinstatement fee required under subsection (b) of this section; and
 - (3) complying with the bond requirement of § 10-206 of this subtitle.
 - (b) (1) The fee for a reinstatement under this section shall be:
- (i) the amount charged for a full renewal period for the type of [certificate of qualification] LICENSE held by the person seeking the reinstatement; and
- (c) A person whose insurance adviser's [certificate of qualification] LICENSE has expired is prohibited from acting as an insurance adviser until the effective date of reinstatement of the [certificate of qualification] LICENSE.
- (d) A person who does not comply with subsection (a) of this section on or before September 30 of the year of expiration shall apply for an insurance adviser's [certificate of qualification] LICENSE under § 10–205 of this subtitle and meet any other requirements specified by the Commissioner in regulation.
