(2) DIVERSE BACKGROUNDS.

(C) A MAJORITY OF THE ~~MEMBERSHIP~~ MEMBERS SHALL BE INDIVIDUALS WITH DISABILITIES.

(D) (1) THE TERM OF ~~AN APPOINTED~~ A MEMBER IS 3 YEARS.

(2) THE TERMS OF THE MEMBERS ~~APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR SHALL BE~~ ARE STAGGERED ~~FROM THE INITIAL APPOINTMENT AS REQUIRED BY THE TERMS PROVIDED FOR THE MEMBERS OF THE COMMISSION ON JULY 1, 2004.~~

(E) AT THE END OF A TERM, A MEMBER CONTINUES TO SERVE UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.
