- (2) PROHIBIT OR RESTRICT CONTACT BETWEEN THE STATE AND THE PLACE AFFECTED BY THE DISEASE; AND
- (3) TAKE OTHER ACTIONS THAT APPEAR TO THE GOVERNOR TO BE NECESSARY TO CARRY OUT THIS SECTION.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from former Art. 41, § 2-406.

In item (2) of this section, the reference to "contact" is substituted for the former reference to "intercourse" for clarity. Correspondingly, the archaic reference to "communications" is deleted.

In item (3) of this section, the reference to "other" actions is added for clarity.

The Review Committee notes, for consideration of the General Assembly, that this provision of law was enacted in 1793 and may need to be updated to include modes of transport other than vessels.

SUBTITLE 11. COMMUNITY SERVICES TRUST FUND.

24-1101. DEFINITIONS.

(A) IN GENERAL.
