14-3A-05. DIRECTIVE FOR ISOLATION OR QUARANTINE.

(A) IN GENERAL.

IF THE SECRETARY OR OTHER DESIGNATED OFFICIAL REQUIRES AN INDIVIDUAL OR A GROUP OF INDIVIDUALS TO GO TO AND REMAIN IN PLACES OF ISOLATION OR QUARANTINE UNDER § 14–3A–03(B)(3) OF THIS SUBTITLE, THE SECRETARY SHALL ISSUE A DIRECTIVE TO THE INDIVIDUAL OR GROUP OF INDIVIDUALS.

- (B) CONTENTS AND NOTICE.
 - (1) THE DIRECTIVE SHALL SPECIFY:
- (I) THE IDENTITY OF THE INDIVIDUAL OR GROUP OF INDIVIDUALS THAT ARE SUBJECT TO ISOLATION OR QUARANTINE;
- (II) THE PREMISES THAT ARE SUBJECT TO ISOLATION OR QUARANTINE;
- (III) THE DATE AND TIME WHEN THE ISOLATION OR QUARANTINE STARTS;
- (IV) THE SUSPECTED DEADLY AGENT CAUSING THE OUTBREAK OR DISEASE, IF KNOWN;
- (V) THE JUSTIFICATION FOR THE ISOLATION OR QUARANTINE;
- (VI) THE AVAILABILITY OF A HEARING TO CONTEST THE DIRECTIVE.
- (2) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (3) OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE DIRECTIVE SHALL BE:
 - (I) IN WRITING; AND
