that are attributable to the taxation of instruments of writing that transfer title to parcels of land that are entirely woodland; and

- (2) Revenues collected by the Department from the payment of charges imposed for Department assistance in implementation of an approved practice.
 - (c) The Department shall use the Woodland Incentives Fund [to]:
- (1) TO help fund the Woodland Incentives Program and the cost-share assistance provided for in this subtitle; AND
- (2) FOR ADMINISTRATIVE COSTS CALCULATED IN ACCORDANCE WITH \S 1–103(B)(2) OF THIS ARTICLE.
- (d) Any unexpended funds remaining in the Woodland Incentives Fund at the end of the fiscal year may not revert to the General Fund of the State.

- (A) There is a Fair Hill Improvement Fund in the Department, to be used for the operation, maintenance, development, and improvement of the Fair Hill facilities at Fair Hill, Maryland.
- (B) (1) Any money obtained by the Department from Fair Hill shall be credited to the Fair Hill Improvement Fund.
- (2) MONEYS IN THE FAIR HILL IMPROVEMENT FUND MAY BE USED FOR ADMINISTRATIVE COSTS CALCULATED IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 1–103(B)(2) OF THIS ARTICLE.

- (A) There is a Somers Cove Marina Improvement Fund in the Department, to be used for the operation, maintenance, development, and improvement of the Somers Cove Marina facilities in Crisfield, Maryland.
- (B) (1) Any money obtained by the Department from Somers Cove Marina shall be credited to the Somers Cove Marina Improvement Fund.
- (2) MONEYS IN THE SOMERS COVE MARINA IMPROVEMENT FUND MAY BE USED FOR ADMINISTRATIVE COSTS CALCULATED IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 1-103(B)(2) OF THIS ARTICLE.

- (A) The Natural Resources Property Maintenance Fund is created within the Department to be used for the maintenance, repair, and management of property owned by the Department.
- (B) MONEYS IN THE FUND MAY BE USED FOR ADMINISTRATIVE COSTS CALCULATED IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 1–103(B)(2) OF THIS ARTICLE. 5–1501.
