

that are attributable to the taxation of instruments of writing that transfer title to parcels of land that are entirely woodland; and

(2) Revenues collected by the Department from the payment of charges imposed for Department assistance in implementation of an approved practice.

(c) The Department shall use the Woodland Incentives Fund [to]:

(1) TO help fund the Woodland Incentives Program and the cost-share assistance provided for in this subtitle; AND

(2) FOR ADMINISTRATIVE COSTS CALCULATED IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 1-103(B)(2) OF THIS ARTICLE.

(d) Any unexpended funds remaining in the Woodland Incentives Fund at the end of the fiscal year may not revert to the General Fund of the State.

(A) There is a Fair Hill Improvement Fund in the Department, to be used for the operation, maintenance, development, and improvement of the Fair Hill facilities at Fair Hill, Maryland.

(B) (1) Any money obtained by the Department from Fair Hill shall be credited to the Fair Hill Improvement Fund.

(2) MONEYS IN THE FAIR HILL IMPROVEMENT FUND MAY BE USED FOR ADMINISTRATIVE COSTS CALCULATED IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 1-103(B)(2) OF THIS ARTICLE.

5-908.1.

(A) There is a Somers Cove Marina Improvement Fund in the Department, to be used for the operation, maintenance, development, and improvement of the Somers Cove Marina facilities in Crisfield, Maryland.

(B) (1) Any money obtained by the Department from Somers Cove Marina shall be credited to the Somers Cove Marina Improvement Fund.

(2) MONEYS IN THE SOMERS COVE MARINA IMPROVEMENT FUND MAY BE USED FOR ADMINISTRATIVE COSTS CALCULATED IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 1-103(B)(2) OF THIS ARTICLE.

5-909.

(A) The Natural Resources Property Maintenance Fund is created within the Department to be used for the maintenance, repair, and management of property owned by the Department.

(B) MONEYS IN THE FUND MAY BE USED FOR ADMINISTRATIVE COSTS CALCULATED IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 1-103(B)(2) OF THIS ARTICLE.

There is a Heritage Conservation Fund in the Department.
