#### (House Bill 1132)

### AN ACT concerning

# Environment - Controlled Hazardous Substance Facility - Permit Term

FOR the purpose of extending the maximum term of a <u>certain</u> controlled hazardous substance facility <u>permit permits</u>; and generally relating to controlled hazardous substance facility permits.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## Article - Environment

7 - 238.

- (a) (1) Unless it is renewed for another term, a facility permit expires on the expiration date the Department specifies at issuance or renewal.
- (2) Unless the controlled hazardous substance facility is a low-level nuclear waste facility, the Department may not issue a facility permit for a term longer than [5] 10 years. The Department may issue a low-level nuclear waste facility permit for a term not longer than 5 years.
  - (b) The Department may renew a facility permit if the permit holder:
    - (1) Has complied with all appropriate rules and regulations;
    - (2) Pays to the Department the renewal fee set by the Department; and
- (3) Submits to the Department a renewal application on the form the Department requires.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2004.
