## (House Bill 1146)

AN ACT concerning

## Juvenile Causes - Children in Out-of-Home Placement - Uniform Plan for a System of Outcomes Evaluation

FOR the purpose of requiring the Office for Children, Youth, and Families, the Department of Juvenile Services, the Department of Human Resources, the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene, and the Developmental Disabilities Administration, and the State Department of Education to develop, test, and implement to plan and determine the cost of testing and implementing a certain systematic evaluation of services provided to children in out-of-home placement; providing for the Office for Children, Youth, and Families to serve as the lead agency to develop plan and determine the cost of implementing the uniform system of outcomes evaluation; providing for the Department of Human Resources, the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene, the Developmental Disabilities Administration, the State Department of Education, the Department of Juvenile Services, and the Office for Children, Youth, and Families to serve as cooperating departments; establishing the purpose of the system as a method of evaluating the value of services to children in out-of-home placement and the resulting outcomes for the children; requiring authorizing the departments to consult with certain resources in higher education in developing and implementing planning the system; requiring the departments, in developing the plan, to maintain ensure the confidentiality of certain personal information concerning children in out-of-home placement; requiring the cooperating departments, in developing the plan, to facilitate ensure the participation of their residential facilities and the facilities operated by private agencies with which the cooperating departments contract in providing necessary data to the system; requiring the departments to meet certain completion and implementation planning and reporting goals on or before certain dates; requiring the Governor and secretary of each cooperating department to include certain funds in the budget for each department; requiring the departments to submit eertain reports a certain plan and a certain report to the General Assembly on or before eertain-dates a certain date; requiring the cooperation of certain departments in developing planning the system; defining certain terms; making a stylistic change; and generally relating to developing planning a uniform system of evaluating the performance of services to and resulting outcomes for children in out-of-home placement.
