(ii) In addition to paragraph (1)(i) of this subsection and notwithstanding  $\S 1-102(a)(4)$  of this article, the Board of License Commissioners may issue a one-day special Class C beer license or a one-day special Class C beer and wine license to a community swimming pool club.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 2004.

## CHAPTER 51

(House Bill 561)

AN ACT concerning

Montgomery County - Alcoholic Beverages - Restaurants - East County License

## MC 403-04

FOR the purpose of creating in Montgomery County an East County Class B (restaurant) beer, wine and liquor (on-sale) license; allowing a licensee to hold an East County license in combination with certain other alcoholic beverages licenses; specifying the boundaries of the area in which a restaurant with an East County license may be located; making a certain licensing requirement inapplicable to the holder of an East County license; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages licenses in Montgomery County.

- (b) (1) In this section the following words have the meanings indicated.
  - (2) "Board" means the Board of License Commissioners.
- (3) "Enterprise zone" has the meaning specified in Article 83A,  $\S$  5–401(f) of the Code.
