enforce State law with a certain exception throughout the State without limitations as to jurisdiction; and generally relating to police officers in the State granting a United States Park Police officer certain powers to enforce Maryland law within areas of the National Park System; authorizing a United States Park Police officer to issue a citation under certain circumstances; requiring the United States Park Police to reimburse the District Court for the printing of certain citation forms; and generally relating to the authority of the United States Park Police.
