

1. THE B-CI LICENSE IS VOIDED; AND
2. THE HOLDER SHALL RETURN THE B-CI LICENSE TO THE BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS.

(V) THE BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS MAY ADOPT REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THIS PARAGRAPH.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 2004.

In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, I have today vetoed House Bill 479 – *Unemployment Insurance Funding Task Force – Extension*.

Senate Bill 262, which was passed by the General Assembly and signed by me on May 11, 2004, accomplishes the same purpose. Therefore, it is not necessary for me to sign House Bill 479.
