House Bill No. 811

AN ACT concerning

Procurement - Percentage Price Preference - Environmentally Preferable Products or Equipment

FOR the purpose of providing a certain price preference for environmentally preferable products or equipment under certain circumstances; requiring the Board of Public Works to adopt certain regulations concerning the establishment of a certain percentage price preference; requiring certain units of State government to establish a list of acceptable environmentally preferable products or equipment; requiring each unit of State government to review certain procurement specifications and, to the extent practicable, require the use of a percentage price preference in their purchase of environmentally preferable products or equipment; defining a certain term; repealing certain obsolete language; and generally relating to a percentage price preference for the procurement of environmentally preferable products or equipment.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - State Finance and Procurement

14-405.

- (a) (1) In this section the following words have the meanings indicated.
- (2) "ENVIRONMENTALLY PREFERABLE PRODUCTS OR EQUIPMENT" MEANS PRODUCTS, INCLUDING SUPPLIES, AND EQUIPMENT MANUFACTURED AND DESIGNED FOR UTILIZATION IN ACCORDANCE WITH A BROAD RANGE OF MEASURES THAT PREVENT OR MINIMIZE ENVIRONMENTAL DEGRADATION, INCLUDING:
 - (I) RECYCLING;
 - (II) RESOURCE CONSERVATION;
 - (III) SOURCE REDUCTION;
- (IV) USE OF COMPONENTS THAT ARE FREE OF TOXIC OR DEGRADING AGENTS OR CONTAIN THE LEAST AMOUNT OF TOXIC OR DEGRADING AGENTS NECESSARY TO MEET APPLICABLE JOB SPECIFICATIONS;
 - (V) USE OF INNOVATIVE TECHNOLOGY; AND
 - (VI) USE OF RENEWABLE RESOURCES; AND
