- (c) "Insurance fraud" means:
 - (1) a violation of Title 27, Subtitle 4 of this article;
- (2) theft, as set out in §§ 7-101 through 7-104 of the Criminal Law Article:
 - (i) from a person regulated under this article; or
- (ii) by a person regulated under this article or an officer, director, agent, or employee of a person regulated under this article; [or]
- (3) KNOWINGLY OBTAINING BENEFITS TO WHICH A PERSON IS NOT ENTITLED UNDER § 9–310.1 OF THE LABOR AND EMPLOYMENT ARTICLE:
- $\frac{(4)}{}$ A VIOLATION OF \S 9–1106 OF THE LABOR AND EMPLOYMENT ARTICLE; OR
- [(3)] (5) (4) any other fraudulent activity that is committed by or against a person regulated under this article and is a violation of:
 - (i) Title 1, Subtitle 3 of the Agriculture Article;
- (ii) Title 19, Subtitle 2 or Subtitle 3 of the Business Regulation Article;
- (iii) Title 14, Subtitle 29, 11–810, 14–1316, or 14–1317 of the Commercial Law Article;
- (iv) the Criminal Law Article other than Title 8, Subtitle 2, Part II or § 10-614;
 - (v) § 14-127 of the Real Property Article;
 - (vi) Article 2B, Title 22 of the Code;
 - (vii) § 109 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Caroline County;
 - (viii) § 4-103 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Carroll County; or
 - (ix) § 8A-1 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Talbot County.

The Fraud Division:

- (1) has the authority to investigate each person suspected of engaging in insurance fraud;
 - (2) if appropriate after an investigation:
- (i) <u>shall refer suspected cases of insurance fraud to the Office of the Attorney General or appropriate local State's Attorney to prosecute the person criminally for insurance fraud;</u>
