- (2) IF, WHILE THE PROGRAM IS IN EFFECT, THE GOVERNOR AND CENERAL ASSEMBLY FAIL TO APPROPRIATE ANY OR ALL OF THE INDIVIDUAL FUND AMOUNTS SPECIFIED IN SUBSECTIONS (B) THROUGH (F) OF THIS SECTION IN ANY GIVEN FISCAL YEAR, THE BASELINE BUDGET OF THE AFFECTED DEPARTMENT OR UNIT SHALL BE INCREASED IN THE NEXT YEAR BY THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN THE AMOUNT SPECIFIED IN THIS SECTION AND THE AMOUNT ACTUALLY APPROPRIATED.
- (3) IF IN 2 OR MORE FISCAL YEARS THE COVERNOR AND GENERAL ASSEMBLY FAIL TO APPROPRIATE ANY OR ALL OF THE INDIVIDUAL FUND AMOUNTS SPECIFIED IN SUBSECTIONS (B) THROUGH (F) OF THIS SECTION IN ANY GIVEN FISCAL YEAR, THE BASELINE BUDGET INCREASE REQUIRED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION SHALL BE CALCULATED WITH A CUMULATIVE EFFECT.

- (A) WITHIN 90 DAYS AFTER THE START OF EACH FISCAL YEAR, THE DEPARTMENT OF BUDGET AND MANAGEMENT SHALL REPORT ON THE PROGRAM TO THE WESTERN MARYLAND, SOUTHERN MARYLAND, EASTERN SHORE, AND HARFORD COUNTY DELECATIONS TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, AND, SUBJECT TO § 2–1246 OF THE STATE COVERNMENT ARTICLE, TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY.
