- ONE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE COMMERCIAL SEAFOOD HARVESTING AND PROCESSING INDUSTRY:
- (VI) ONE INDIVIDUAL WITH KNOWLEDGE AND EXPERIENCE IN THE AREA OF OPERATING COMMERCIAL FOOD OR FIBER PROCESSING FACILITIES:
- (VII) ONE INDIVIDUAL WITH KNOWLEDGE AND EXPERIENCE IN THE AREA OF PUBLIC FINANCE:

(VIII) ONE INDIVIDUAL WITH KNOWLEDGE AND EXPERIENCE IN THE AREA OF RURAL ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT OR AGRICULTURAL MARKETING; AND

- (IX) ONE INDIVIDUAL WITH KNOWLEDGE ABOUT THE AGRICULTURAL, FORESTRY, OR SEAFOOD INDUSTRIES OR AGRITOURISM IN THE STATE OR WITH SUBSTANTIAL AND RELEVANT ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT EXPERIENCE.
- (C) (1) IN APPOINTING BOARD MEMBERS UNDER SUBSECTION (B)(2) OF THIS SECTION. THE GOVERNOR SHALL CONSIDER ALL OF THE GEOGRAPHIC REGIONS OF THE STATE.
 - A BOARD MEMBER MUST BE A RESIDENT OF THE STATE. (2)
 - (3) A BOARD MEMBER:
 - SERVES WITHOUT COMPENSATION: BUT
- (II) IS ENTITLED TO REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES UNDER THE STANDARD STATE TRAVEL REGULATIONS AS PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET.
- THE GOVERNOR MAY REMOVE A BOARD MEMBER FOR INCOMPETENCE, MISCONDUCT, OR FAILURE TO PERFORM THE DUTIES OF THE POSITION.
- (D) (1) THE TERM OF A BOARD MEMBER APPOINTED UNDER SUBSECTION (B)(2) OF THIS SECTION IS 4 YEARS.
- THE TERMS OF THE APPOINTED MEMBERS ARE STAGGERED AS REQUIRED BY THE TERMS PROVIDED FOR THE MEMBERS ON JULY 1, 2004.
- AT THE END OF A TERM. AN APPOINTED MEMBER CONTINUES TO SERVE UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.
- A MEMBER WHO IS APPOINTED AFTER A TERM HAS BEGUN SERVES ONLY FOR THE REST OF THE TERM AND UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.
 - (\mathbf{E}) THE BOARD SHALL ELECT A CHAIR FROM AMONG ITS MEMBERS.
 - (F) THE BOARD MAY ACT WITH AN AFFIRMATIVE VOTE OF NINE MEMBERS.
