SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Health Occupations

19–202.

- (a) (1) The Board consists of 11 members.
- (2) Of the 11 Board members:
- (i) 9 shall be licensed social workers of whom:
1. Subject to paragraph (3) of this subsection, 1 is a licensed social work associate;
 2. Subject to paragraph (3) of this subsection, 1 is a licensed graduate social worker at the time of appointment;
 3. ~~[At]~~ **SUBJECT TO PARAGRAPH (3) OF THIS SUBSECTION, AT least 1 is a licensed certified social worker;**
 4. ~~At~~ **SUBJECT TO PARAGRAPH (3) OF THIS SUBSECTION, AT least 4 are licensed certified social workers—clinical; and**
 5. 1 is a licensed social worker employed by the Department of Human Resources; and
- (ii) 2 shall be consumer members.
- (3) If a licensed social work associate ~~or~~, a licensed graduate social worker, ~~OR A LICENSED CERTIFIED SOCIAL WORKER, OR A LICENSED SOCIAL WORKER—CLINICAL~~ is not appointed to the Board under ~~[paragraph (2)(i)1 and 2]~~ **PARAGRAPH (2)(I)** of this subsection within 6 months of a vacancy, a licensee of any license level shall be appointed immediately if that licensee is qualified to be a member of the Board under subsections (b) and (d) of this section.
- (4) The Governor shall appoint all members of the Board with the advice of the Secretary and the advice and consent of the Senate.
- (5) The Governor shall appoint all social work members of the Board from a list of nominees containing names submitted by:
- (i) Professional social work associations in the State;
