Howard County – Board of Education – Membership

FOR the purpose of increasing the membership of the Howard County Board of Education; providing for staggered terms of office for the additional members; and generally relating to an increase in the membership of the Howard County Board of Education.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Education

3-701.

(a) The Howard County Board consists of [five] SEVEN members.

(b) A candidate elected to the County Board shall be a resident and registered voter of Howard County. Any member who no longer resides in Howard County may not continue as a member of the Board.

(c) Members of the Howard County Board shall be elected:

(1) At the general election every 2 years as required by subsection (d) of this section; and

(2) From Howard County at large.

(d) (1) (i) The terms of the members are staggered as provided in this subsection.
