(c) [Subject to subsection (c-1) of this section, a] A recipient of an Economic Development Student Assistance Grant under this subtitle shall:

- (1) Be a resident of the State;
- (2) Be selected by the Office from qualified applicants based on standards established and approved by the Commission;
- (3) Sign a letter of intent to enroll at an eligible institution in the State in an eligible program as specified for each field in which there is a geographic or critical shortage in this State as provided in this subtitle;
- (4) Furnish a [guaranteed] promissory note to the Commission or its designee with security satisfactory to the Commission;
- (5) After completion of studies in an eligible program, perform the service obligation as specified for each field in which there is a geographic or critical shortage as provided in this subtitle; and
- (6) Satisfy any additional criteria the Commission may establish.

[(c-1) The provisions of subsection (c)(4) of this section may be waived by the Commission when a recipient is undergoing extraordinary circumstances as determined by the Commission.]

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2004.

**(Senate Bill 35)**

AN ACT concerning

**Motor Vehicle Administration - Driver's License Renewals - Vision  
Screening Test Requirements**
