TITLE 18. RIGHT TO FARM.

237. 18-101.

(A) SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY MAY ADOPT AN ORDINANCE, RESOLUTION, OR REGULATION OR TAKE ANY OTHER ACTION THAT THE COUNTY COUNCIL CONSIDERS NECESSARY TO PROTECT A PERSON'S RIGHT TO FARM OR ENGAGE IN AGRICULTURAL OR FORESTRY OPERATIONS.

(B) BEFORE ADOPTING AN ORDINANCE, RESOLUTION, OR REGULATION OR TAKING OTHER ACTION UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION, THE COUNTY COUNCIL SHALL HOLD A PUBLIC HEARING AND PROVIDE REASONABLE NOTICE OF THE HEARING.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2004.

CHAPTER 104

(Senate Bill 203)

AN ACT concerning

Criminal Law - Carjacking - Possessor of Motor Vehicle

FOR the purpose of establishing that it is not a defense to the crimes of carjacking or armed carjacking for a defendant to not intend to permanently deprive the possessor of a motor vehicle of the possession of the motor vehicle; and generally relating to carjacking and armed carjacking.
