(Senate Bill 228)

AN ACT concerning

Harford County - Light Wines Produced at Wineries - Retail Sale to Consumers

FOR the purpose of authorizing, in Harford County, a winery that has been issued a Class A light wine license to sell to consumers at retail at the winery light wines and certain other wines produced by the winery that are not in excess of a certain percentage of alcohol by volume; and generally relating to the sale of wine by wineries in Harford County.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

4-201.

- (a) A Class A light wine license may be issued only in:
 - (1) Baltimore County;
 - (2) Carroll County;
 - (3) Dorchester County;
 - (4) Frederick County;
 - (5) Garrett County;
 - (6) Harford County;
 - (7) Montgomery County;
 - (8) Somerset County;
 - (9) Talbot County; and
 - (10) Washington County.
- (b) (1) The annual fee for this license is \$50.
 - (2) In Montgomery County the annual license fee is \$100.
