

INFORMATION THAT MEETS THE SPECIFICATIONS REQUIRED FOR FINANCIAL DATA MATCH REPORTS UNDER THE FEDERAL PARENT LOCATOR SERVICE.

(3) A report submitted under paragraph (1) of this subsection shall be provided to the Comptroller in machine-readable form.

(4) The Comptroller shall pay the financial institution a reasonable fee, not to exceed the actual costs incurred by the financial institution to comply with the requirements of this section, less any fees received from other units of the State for the same report.

(5) The Comptroller may institute civil proceedings to enforce this section.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 2004.

CHAPTER 138

(Senate Bill 783)

AN ACT concerning

Public Safety – Task Force to Study Criminal Offender Monitoring by Global Positioning Systems

FOR the purpose of establishing a Task Force to Study Criminal Offender Monitoring by Global Positioning Systems to study how the State can utilize Global Positioning technology to monitor certain individuals who have committed criminal offenses, how law enforcement can benefit from linkage to Global Positioning technology to solve crimes and streamline workload, ~~how such a system could be financed, and the feasibility of implementing a certain program,~~ admissibility of evidence issues, and other issues that the Task Force considers relevant; specifying the membership and duties of the Task Force; requiring the Task Force to make legislative recommendations; requiring that the Governor, to the extent possible, make appointments to the Task Force representing geographically diverse jurisdictions; requiring the Governor to designate the chairman of the Task Force; requiring the Task Force to meet at the times and places that the chairman determines; requiring the Task Force to provide certain reports to the Governor and the General Assembly on or before certain dates; providing for staffing of the Task Force; providing for the termination of this Act; and generally relating to a Task Force to Study Criminal Offender Monitoring by Global Positioning Systems.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That:
