- (3) HAVE A MECHANISM TO RECEIVE COMPLAINTS OR INQUIRIES FROM A SELLER OR BIDDER: AND
- (4) HAVE A MECHANISM TO MAKE A SELLER'S OR BIDDER'S RECISTRATION INFORMATION AVAILABLE TO ANOTHER SELLER OR BIDDER WHO ALLEGES FRAUD OR DECEPTION IN AN AUCTION TRANSACTION.

SECTION 2-3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2004.

## CHAPTER 158

(House Bill 211)

AN ACT concerning

## Family Law - Adoption - Certificates of Birth

FOR the purpose of repealing the provision of law making the entry of an adoption order by a court as grounds for the Secretary of Health and Mental Hygiene to make a new certificate of birth for an individual who was born outside the United States; repealing a certain qualification that a foreign-born adopted person must meet before the Secretary may prepare and register a certificate of foreign birth; and generally relating to certificates of birth.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## Article - Health - General

4-211.

- (b) Except as provided in subsection (c) of this section, the Secretary may make a new certificate of birth for an individual who was born outside the United States if one of the following occurred in this State:
- (1) The previously unwed parents of the individual have married each other after the birth of the individual;
- (2) A court of competent jurisdiction in this State has entered an order as to parentage[,] OR legitimation[, or adoption]; or
