FOR the purpose of ~~increasing from one-half to~~ providing that the full amount of the salaries of the members of the Harford County Liquor Control Board ~~that~~ are to be included as certain operating expenses ~~related to the board's administration and enforcement of the alcoholic beverages laws in Harford County when the board calculates the amount of the deduction it is required to make for those expenses before paying to the county treasurer and the treasurers of the municipal corporations in the county the net proceeds of the funds received by the board from the sale of alcoholic beverages licenses in Harford County under certain circumstances;~~ making certain technical and conforming changes ~~with respect to references to the Liquor Control Board;~~ and generally relating to the Harford County Liquor Control Board.
