

[(4)] (5) In Calvert County and St. Mary's County, a Class A or Class D beer, beer and light wine, or beer, wine and liquor license may not be issued, except by way of renewal, to a person, corporation, or limited liability company holding an alcoholic beverages license in any other state or in Washington, D.C.

[(5)] (6) In Charles County, a Class A or Class D beer, beer and light wine, or beer, wine and liquor license may not be issued, except by way of renewal, to a person, corporation, or limited liability company holding an alcoholic beverages license in any other state or in Washington, D.C.

(7) IN GARRETT COUNTY, A CLASS A OR CLASS D BEER, BEER AND LIGHT WINE, OR BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR LICENSE MAY NOT BE ISSUED, EXCEPT BY WAY OF RENEWAL, TO A PERSON, CORPORATION, OR LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY HOLDING AN ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES LICENSE IN ANY OTHER STATE OR IN WASHINGTON, D.C.

[(6)] (8) In Washington County, a Class A or Class D beer, beer and light wine, or beer, wine and liquor license may not be issued, except by way of renewal, to a person, corporation, or limited liability company holding an alcoholic beverages license in any other state or in Washington, D.C.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect ~~October~~ July 1, 2004.

## CHAPTER 177

### (House Bill 474)

AN ACT concerning

### **Education - High School Diploma - World War II, Korean Conflict, and Vietnam Conflict Veterans**

FOR the purpose of allowing an individual honorably discharged from military service to apply to certain county boards of education to obtain a high school diploma if the individual withdrew from a certain full-time public or private school under certain circumstances; and generally relating to high school diplomas for certain veterans.
