SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- (a) This section applies only in Washington County.
- (b) A special wine tasting license (WTL) may be issued only to a holder of a Class A (off-sale) beer, wine and liquor license OR A CLASS B (ON-OFF SALE) BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR LICENSE.

(c) (1) A holder of any class of retail alcoholic beverages license or an employee designated by the holder shall complete training in an approved alcohol
