- (ii) On the exterior and interior, where appropriate, of the historic structures.
- (b) The easement must be in form and substance acceptable to the Trust and the extent of the interest to be encumbered must be acceptable to the Trust.
- (7) THE GRANTEE HAS UNTIL JUNE 1, 2006, TO ENCUMBER OR EXPEND THE PROCEEDS OF THE LOAN THE PROCEEDS OF THE LOAN MUST BE ENCUMBERED BY THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS OR EXPENDED FOR THE PURPOSES PROVIDED IN THIS ACT NO LATER THAN JUNE 1, 2006.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect $\underbrace{October\ June}$ 1, 2004.
