**CHAPTER 215**

**(House Bill 1022)**

AN ACT concerning

**Washington County - Tip Jar Gaming - Licenses**

FOR the purpose of altering the requirements to sell or wholesale for profit a tip jar packet in Washington County; clarifying that a person must have a license to sell or wholesale for profit a tip jar packet; applying a certain residency requirement only to volunteer fire companies or volunteer rescue companies; making a tip jar licensee, holder of an interest in a tip jar license, or person who is an immediate family member of a licensee or holder of an interest in a tip jar license ineligible to sell or wholesale for profit a tip jar packet; making certain persons in which a stockholder or member is a tip jar licensee ineligible to sell or wholesale for profit a tip jar packet; repealing a certain maximum limit for gross profits from a tip jar; requiring the Washington County Gaming Commission to submit an annual report to the Comptroller; providing for the application of this Act; making certain technical corrections; and generally relating to tip jar licenses in Washington County.
