- (i) County Commissioner serving as an ex officio member of the County Board; or
- (ii) Nonvoting student member selected under subsection (f) of this section.
 - (b) The Allegany County Board consists of:
 - (1) Five elected members;
- (2) The Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners, or any County Commissioner so designated by the Chairman, who is an ex officio nonvoting member; and
- (3) One nonvoting student member, who is to advise the other members of the County Board on the viewpoint of students who attend Allegany County public schools.
- (c) An individual nominated for membership as an elected member on the County Board shall be a qualified voter and a resident of Allegany County for at least [3 years] 1 YEAR BEFORE THE ELECTION.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2004.
