- (a) Within 30 days after the first meeting of the Commission after [an examination date] SUBMISSION OF A COMPLETED APPLICATION, the Commission shall notify an applicant in writing:

  - (2)] whether the application for a license is approved or denied; and
  - [(3)] (2) of the reasons for denial, if the application is denied.

## Agriculture - State Board of Veterinary Medical Examiners Fund
