**CHAPTER 252**

**(Senate Bill 139)**

AN ACT concerning

**Criminal Procedure – ~~Police Officers~~ – United States Park Police – Authority to Enforce Maryland Law in National Park System**

FOR the purpose of ~~adding members of the United States Park Police to the list of police officers authorized to make arrests, conduct investigations, and otherwise enforce State law with a certain exception throughout the State without limitations as to jurisdiction; and generally relating to police officers in the State granting a United States Park Police officer certain powers to enforce Maryland law within areas of the National Park System; authorizing a United States Park Police officer to issue a citation under certain circumstances; requiring the United States Park Police to reimburse the District Court for the printing of certain citation forms; and generally relating to the authority of the United States Park Police.~~
