 - (1) A CHANGE IN THE RESIDENT'S CONDITION:
- (2) THE ADVERSE EVENT THAT MAY RESULT IN A CHANCE IN THE RESIDENT'S CONDITION;
- (3) THE OUTCOME OF CARE THAT RESULTS IN AN UNANTICIPATED CONSEQUENCE; AND
 - (4) THE CORRECTIVE ACTION TAKEN, IF ANY.
- $\stackrel{\mbox{\scriptsize (D)}}{\rightarrow}$ A WRITTEN NOTICE REQUIRED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION SHALL BE:
- $\stackrel{\mbox{\scriptsize (1)}}{\leftarrow}$ CONSISTENT WITH ALL FEDERAL AND STATE CONFIDENTIALITY LAWS; AND
 - (2) SENT IN A TIMELY MANNER.
- (E) THE SECRETARY MAY, FOR A VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION, IMPOSE AN ADMINISTRATIVE PENALTY UP TO:
 - (1) \$500 FOR A FIRST VIOLATION; AND
 - (2) \$1,000 FOR A SUBSEQUENT, REPEATED VIOLATION.

 - (V) ONSET OF AGGRESSIVE OR INAPPROPRIATE BEHAVIOR:
- (3) THE NEED TO DISCONTINUE A MEDICATION OR TREATMENT BECAUSE OF:
