- 3. APPROVED BY THE OWNER OF THE HOME OR BUILDING, IF NOT THE INDIVIDUAL, WHO ACREES THAT THE INDIVIDUAL WILL BE ALLOWED TO REMAIN IN THE RESIDENCE FOR AT LEAST 1 YEAR:
- 4. PROVIDED FOR A INDIVIDUAL WHO DOES NOT LIVE IN A LICENSED ASSISTED LIVING FACILITY:
- 5. REQUIRED BECAUSE OF THE RESIDENCE'S PHYSICAL STRUCTURE AND THE INDIVIDUAL'S SPECIAL FUNCTIONAL NEEDS; AND
- 6. REASONABLE AND NECESSARY TO PREVENT THE INDIVIDUAL'S INSTITUTIONALIZATION OR HOSPITALIZATION.
- (II) "ENVIRONMENTAL ACCESSIBILITY MODIFICATION" INCLUDES THE COST, INSTALLATION, MAINTENANCE, AND REPAIR OF:
 - 1. RAMPS:
 - 2. GRAB BARS OR HANDRAILS;
 - 3. STAIR CLIDES:
 - 4. WIDENING OF DOORWAYS:
- 5. MODIFICATION OF BATHROOM FACILITIES OR KITCHEN FACILITIES TO MAKE THEM ACCESSIBLE TO A PHYSICALLY IMPAIRED INDIVIDUAL:
- 6. LOCK, BUZZER, OR OTHER DEVICE ON A DOOR TO PREVENT OR STOP A COCNITIVELY IMPAIRED INDIVIDUAL FROM WANDERING:
- 7. HOME MODIFICATIONS TO HELP A COGNITIVELY IMPAIRED INDIVIDUAL IDENTIFY THE PHYSICAL ENVIRONMENT AND FIND THE BATHROOM: AND
- 8. SPECIALIZED ELECTRICAL AND PLUMBING SYSTEMS TO ACCOMMODATE THE MEDICAL EQUIPMENT AND SUPPLIES THAT ARE NECESSARY FOR AN INDIVIDUAL'S WELFARE.
- (III) "ENVIRONMENTAL ACCESSIBILITY MODIFICATION" DOES NOT INCLUDE ADAPTATIONS OR IMPROVEMENTS TO AN INDIVIDUAL'S HOME OR PLACE OF RESIDENCE, SUCH AS CARPETING, ROOF REPAIR, AND CENTRAL AIR CONDITIONING, WHICH:
 - 1. ARE OF GENERAL UTILITY;
- 2. ARE NOT OF DIRECT MEDICAL OR REMEDIAL BENEFIT TO AN INDIVIDUAL; OR
 - 3. ADD TO THE HOME'S TOTAL SQUARE FOOTAGE.
