through—the Department of Justice's State—and Foderal Clinics and System Demonstration—Project—and—the Crime—Victime'—Rights—Enforcement—Project—is terminated or reduced below-a total of \$500,000 per fiscal year, the Governor shall include in the annual budget bill-each year—an appropriation to the State-Victime of Crime Fund of \$500,000 less any funding provided by the federal projects and any amount distributed to the Fund under the provisions of this Act.

SECTION 3-2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2007.
