AN ACT concerning

Certified Social Workers-Clinical - Practice - Definition

FOR the purpose of altering the definition of "practice social work" so as to authorize a licensed certified social worker-clinical to practice social work by evaluating, diagnosing, and treating certain mental and emotional conditions and impairments in addition to certain other conditions and disorders; and generally relating to defining the practice of social work for certified social workers-clinical.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND. That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Health Occupations

19-101.

- In this title the following words have the meanings indicated. (a)
- "Board" means the State Board of Social Work Examiners. (b)
- "Certified" means having demonstrated to the satisfaction of the Board that the individual has completed 2 years of supervised social work practice as defined in § 19-302(d) or (e) of this title.
- "License" means, unless the context requires otherwise, one of four types of licenses issued by the Board authorizing an individual to practice:
 - Associate social work: (1)
 - (2)Graduate social work;
 - (3) Certified social work; or
