FOR the purpose of increasing the maximum amount of the additional marriage license fee that the Prince George's County Council is authorized to set; requiring the elerk to pay <u>Director of Finance of Prince George's County to distribute</u> the proceeds from the additional marriage license fee to the Family Crisis Center of Prince George's County; <u>providing that, if the Family Crisis Center changes its name or objectives or ceases to exist, the proceeds shall be used to fund certain programs</u>; and generally relating to marriage license fees in Prince George's County.

- (a) (1) The fee for a license is \$10.
