(House Bill 1189)

AN ACT concerning

Transportation – Maryland Senior Rides Program – Repeal of Grant Limitations

FOR the purpose of altering the name of a certain program to be the Maryland Senior Rides Program; repealing certain caps on the annual and total number of grants that a participant in the Maryland Senior Rides Program may receive; altering a certain cap on the total dollar amount of grants that the Maryland Transit Administration may award annually under the Program; repealing certain caps on the total dollar amount and a certain cap on the dollar amount per applicant that the Maryland Transit Administration may award annually under the Program; repealing a certain cap on the dollar amount that the Administration may award annually under the Program for use in certain regions of the State; altering a certain definition; and generally relating to the repeal of certain grant limitations for the Maryland Senior Rides Program.
